

LIGHTS OUT INDY!



- The Mississippi Flyway, a migratory bird pathway, passes through Indianapolis
- The Indianapolis skyline is home to 19 buildings over 75 meters = a lot of light
- A confused bird may "follow" the light and find itself surrounded by buildings
- Disoriented birds then collide with windows




