

EXAMPLE 7 SEMESTER PLAN FOR HEALTH SCIENCE MAJOR

This is one example of a semester-by-semester course plan that satisfies the requirements for a **health science major**. This is just one example, there are many possible variations. This example includes an **optional Medical Spanish Concentration** within the major and strives for an “early” 7 semester completion. It could be easily modified to allow for a full semester study abroad experience if desired, with a typical 8 semester graduation.

Full time tuition is one flat fee in fall and spring for any course load between 12 and 20 credit hours. In this example Fall/Spring semesters range from 16.5 to 17.5 credit hours per semester, with no additional summer classes. Students wishing to take fewer credit hours per semester could choose to take courses in the summer.
